### Stages of alert

#### **ALERT LEVEL ONE: PREPARE**

Covid-19 in NZ, but contained

- Activate border measures
- Contact tracing
- Cancel mass gatherings of more than 500 people
- Stay at home if sick and report flu-like symptoms
- Intensive testing for Covid-19
- Physical distancing encouraged

#### ALERT LEVEL TWO: REDUCE

Contained but risk of community transmission growing

- Entry border measures maximised
- Further restrictions on mass gatherings
- Physical distancing on public transport
- Limit non-essential travel around country
- Employer to begin alternative ways of working if possible (shift work, working from home etc)
- Business contingency plans activated
- High risk people to remain at home (over 70s, people with existing conditions)

#### ALERT LEVEL THREE: RESTRICT

Heightened risk that disease not contained

- Travel in areas of community transmission limited
- Affected educational facilities closed
- Mass gatherings cancelled
- Public venues closed
- Alternative ways of working

- required and some non-essential businesses closed
- Non-face-to-face primary care consultations
- Elective surgeries and procedures deferred and healthcare staff reprioritised

#### **ALERT LEVEL FOUR: ELIMINATE**

Likely that disease not contained

- People to stay at home
- Educational facilities closed
- All non-essential businesses closed
- Rationing of supplies and requisitioning of facilities
- Severe travel restrictions
- Major reprioritisation of healthcare services

Letter to the Twizel Update

COVID-19 (Novel Coronoavirus)

We woke this morning to the news that the iconic Maadi Cup, New Zealand's Secondary School Championship Rowing Regatta to be held at Lake Ruataniwha this year, has been cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Gatherings of more than 500 people are forbidden. Travel around most of the world has been severely restricted. Most people will shortly discover the ramifications of closed borders, disrupted trade, and resource limitation. Events and institution closures such as schools will likely follow.

All this in response to a new virus that we have no immunity to. Most people have few or minor symptoms in the two weeks or so it takes to run its course. However, COVID-19 disproportionally provides more severe health problems – including death - to our elderly and those with major comorbidities (heart and lung diseases especially). Our young and the vast majority in the workforce have markedly less to fear. The Worldometers website provides a good overview of the world situation as this virus is tracked. https://www.worldometers.info/coronavirus/

To date we only have 8 confirmed cases in this country. With the government and health officials taking a strong lead with advice about travel, contact tracing and self-isolation the current aim is to aggressively keep this virus out as long as possible. We need to delay community spread as long as possible. A vaccine to protect us against it is at least a year away (once testing and safety is assured), and multiple trials are underway with conventional and alternative medicines worldwide. Currently only Intensive Care beds with ventilation equipment and Oxygen have been proven to make a difference in outcomes to those severely affected – and these are a limited commodity. If and when this virus gains a hold in our communities efforts will shift to manage the spread so that our ICU and other health resources are not overwhelmed.

So what can we all do to help here?

- ★ First of all stay calm and don't panic! There's plenty of loo paper out there!
- Find out what you need to know from the Ministry of Health website: <a href="https://www.health.govt.nz/our-work/diseases-and-conditions/covid-19-novel-coronavirus/covid-19-novel-coronavirus-health-advice-general-public">https://www.health.govt.nz/our-work/diseases-and-conditions/covid-19-novel-coronavirus/covid-19-novel-coronavirus-health-advice-general-public</a>
- ★ Don't go out if you're sick (Temp > 38deg C/ cough/ shortness of breath)
- ★ If you have these symptoms AND have recently been in contact with someone with COVID-19 or recently been to a country or area of concern get on the phone instead to either HealthLine 0800 358 5453 or your doctor immediately.

- This virus spreads via coughs, sneezes and talking via droplets over short distances onto surrounding surfaces. If you touch those surfaces then touch your eyes/ nose or mouth you may get infected. SO: good hygiene, regularly wash and thoroughly dry your hands, and use good cough etiquette. We should be doing this anyway with any colds and flues coming our way!
- ★ How to protect yourself and others:
- Cough or sneeze into your elbow or by covering your mouth and nose with tissues.
- Put used tissues in the bin or a bag immediately.
- Wash your hands with soap and water often (for at least 20 seconds).
- Try to avoid close contact with people who are unwell.
- Don't touch your eyes, nose or mouth if your hands are not clean.
- Avoid personal contact, such as kissing, sharing cups or food with sick people.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces and objects, such as doorknobs.
- Stay home if you feel unwell.
- ★ Self -isolation is effective and necessary if any contact with someone with proven COVID-19 or travel from overseas for 14 days.
- a. Try to separate yourself from the people you live with: limit travelling except with family members/ avoid visitors other than family, get food delivered.
- b. Avoid more than 15mins within 2metres contact of those you live with (then they don't need to isolate).
- c. Use your own toothbrushes, eating and drinking utensils, dishes, towels, washcloths or bed linen.
- d. Do not share food and drinks. Do not prepare food for others. Wash your clothing and dishes separate to others in your home.
- e. Don't bed share with others and avoid kissing and hugging (it's only 14 days!)
- f. Minimise time in shared spaces (bathrooms/ kitchens and sitting rooms) as much as possible perhaps be the last to use the shower or bathroom each day.
- g. Keep shared spaces well ventilated
- h. Clean surfaces after you use them (especially sinktops/ kitchen benches) soap, diluted household bleach, alcohol solutions (at least 70% alcohol) and most EPA household disinfectants are all effective. This virus is easy to kill.
- i. You can still get out and about but it is important you avoid gatherings or close contact with others.

If everyone follows the advice we can do our bit to help protect ourselves, our loved ones and our community.






