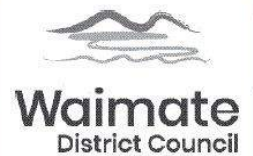

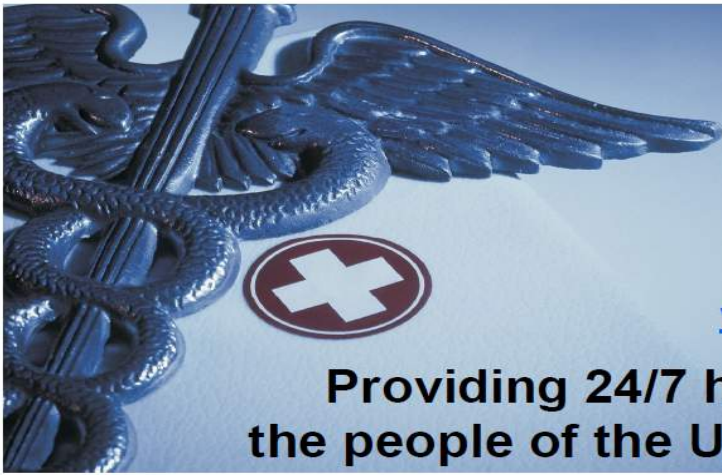
River-T Winery is now under new ownership! Paul and Alisa Nicholls are excited to announce that they are the new owners and would like to take this opportunity to introduce themselves.

Watering down the risks in Waitaki

In colonial times drowning was so rife it was described as the 'NZ Death'... As New Zealand shifted from rugged colonial to settled society, issues around our waterways have resurfaced, now being about where we build.

Waitaki District Council Planning Manager Hamish Barrell said "The rainfall event over New Year that brought misery to the holiday season has again reminded us of how important it is that we plan ahead, thereby reducing risk to the community and emergency services."

Since the shock of Christchurch earthquakes the risk of natural hazards has been better recognised, including by insurers.

Compared to many other parts of New Zealand, the Waitaki District is a relatively safe place and in a COVID ravaged world we have the ability to market ourselves distinctively on this.

But keeping it that way requires some thought up-front.

In terms of looking at natural hazard risk, our current District Plan focuses almost entirely on flooding and this information needs to be revisited and updated.

The District Plan Review will address the potential consequences of climatic change and other locally-relevant environmental considerations.

There will be a new chapter on stormwater and natural hazards, including revised areas of flooding risk from the regional councils and provisions to encourage hydraulic neutrality – that is, we don't want downstream properties to be worse off from any new development upstream.

In addition, we wish to see other natural hazards recognised such as land instability, coastal erosion, fault lines and wild fires.

While the role of regional councils is going to be key, given their function, our local knowledge can be invaluable in informing this process. Photos, memories, experiences and local records of past events, can help build a picture of the environmental challenges certain areas face. Yarns from Station Days in North Otago by John McNair

Birchwood, having surrendered their lease after the 1895 snow, was unoccupied for a good many years. Birchwood was finally taken up by Davy Armstrong who never appeared to make a great success of it. When I first knew Davey he was rabbiting on Ben Ohau Station in 1897. He had a pack of 20 dogs consisting of every known breed. I have spent the greater part of my life in the high country and worked for some tough bosses, but old Davy was the roughest and toughest I have ever met.

He was a man of medium height with steel grey eyes, a grey beard and white eyebrows. Nearly every winter Davy was in trouble with snow-bound sheep stuck in deep snow and a prey to the keas. By going six miles down the road to Ben Avon he could get the use of the telephone and get me to come up and help with the snowbound sheep.

Davy never missed going to the Grand National race meeting every year. One year Jack Little from Ben Avon, knowing Davy was away, thought he would ride up to see how Davy's dogs were getting on for food and Water. Davy had shot a horse on the bank of the water race and tied a dog to each leg.

The Ahuriri River was the boundary between Longslip, Ben Avon, Birchwood and Benmore Stations. At times when the river was low the sheep would cross to Benmore country and someone would have to go to Benmore Station to collect the stragglers and deliver them to their various owners. It once fell to Davy's lot to collect them, but during the time he was away the river rose and he was unable to take them across country and ford the river. He therefore had to cross the bridge at Omarama and stay over night at the hotel.

Davy started off for Longslip the following morning very drunk and a bottle of whisky in his pocket. After passing through the iron gate seven miles from the township the country was open and unfenced, and extended from the Ahuriri River to St Bathans. Someone told Arthur Sutherland, the manager of Omarama Station, that Davy was going up the road with 700 stragglers and was very drunk. He found Davy asleep on the roadside with his horse's reigns tied to his boot and not a sheep to be seen. He shook Davy and said 'where's the sheep' and Davy replied 'They're right as the bank, they're on the island'.

He walked over to the river terrace but there was no sign of sheep on any island. He returned to Davy again shook him and asked 'what island are they on?' Davy replied 'The South Island, you bloody fool.'

Arthur Sutherland had to get some musterers in a hurry and managed to collect the bulk of them. That part of Omarama Station would not have been mustered again until the following shearing.

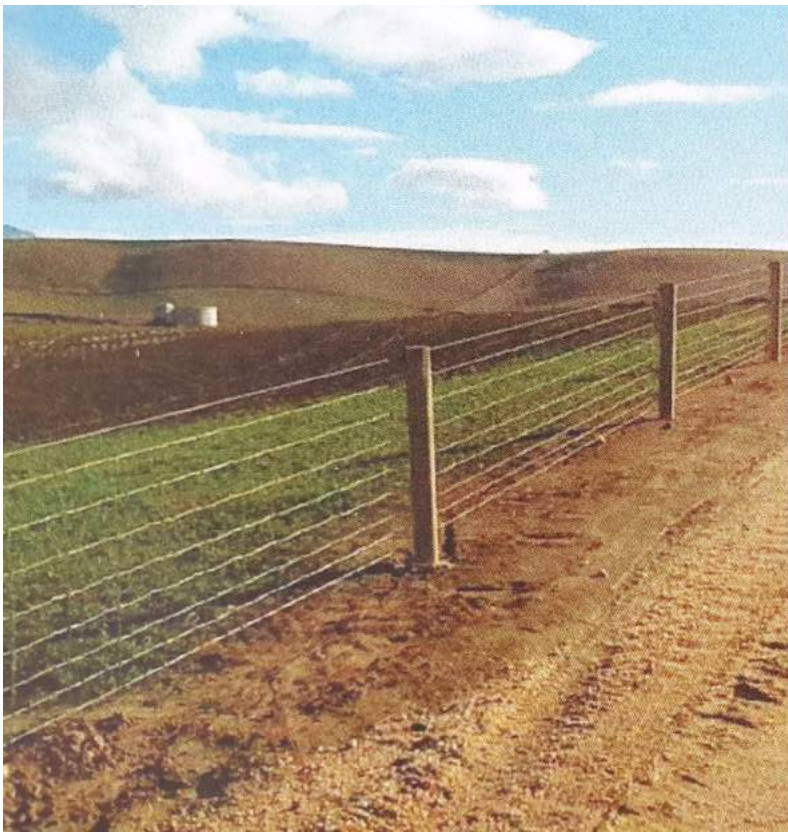

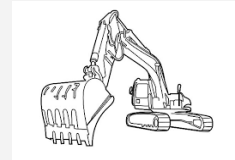
