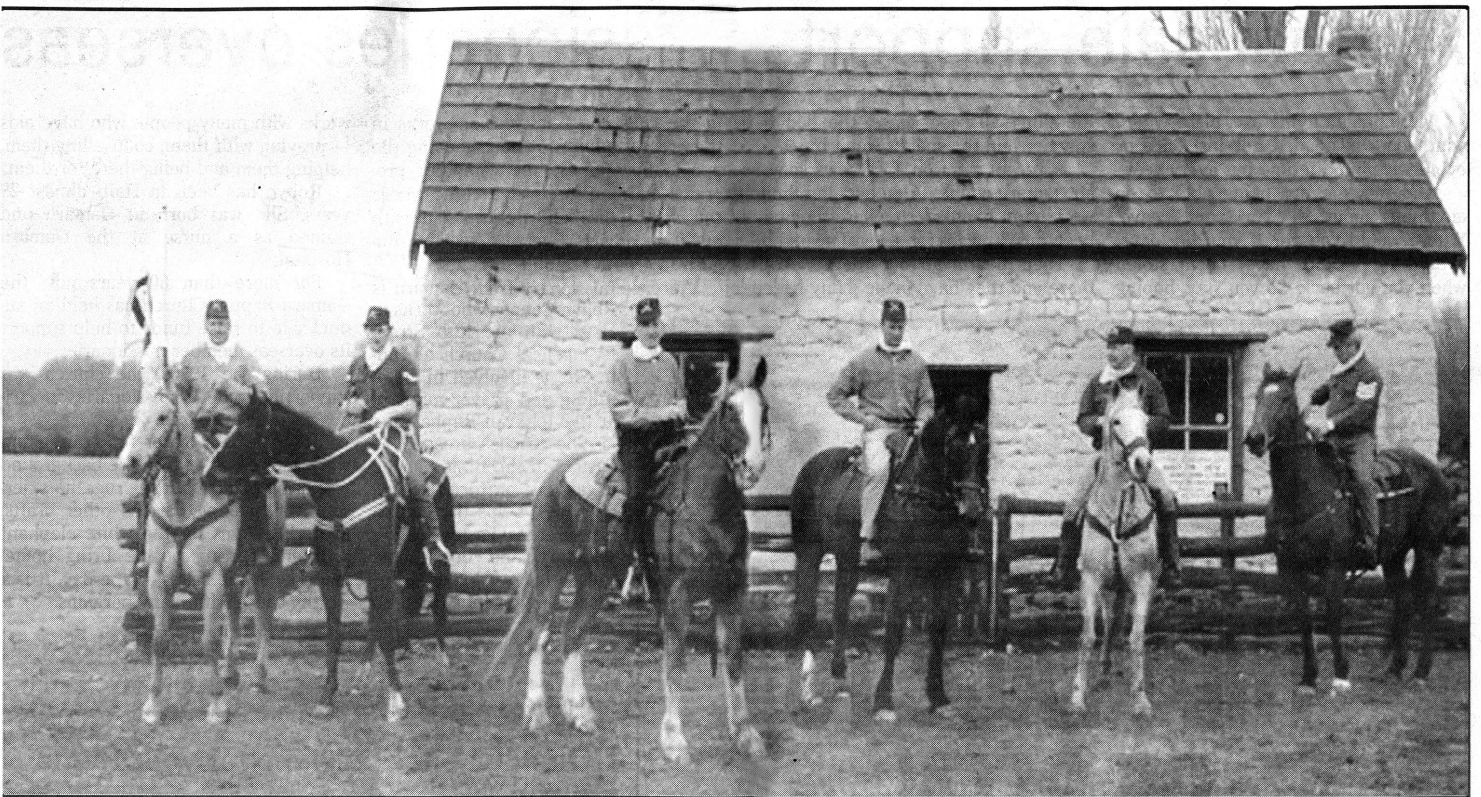

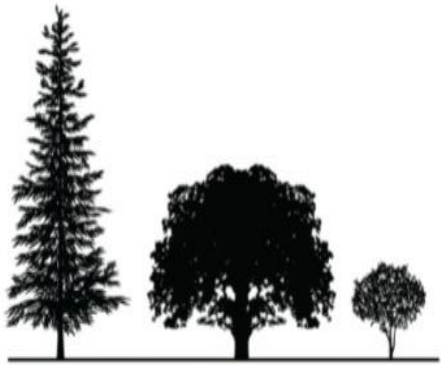

## Reducing your fertiliser use

**Synthetic nitrogen fertiliser use  
is limited on all grazed pasture.**

Nitrogen applied to pasture aids growth, but it can leach into the ground, lowering surface and groundwater quality. Reducing nitrogen use is essential for protecting drinking water and the environment.

The limit of 190kg per hectare per year for synthetic nitrogen fertiliser use applies to all grazed pasture, not just dairy. Canterbury dairy farmers: report your use to us by the end of July.

# Kurow Hill Report June 2023

The Kurow Hill viewpoint accessibility Project just got a step closer to starting with a grant from the Network Waitaki Powering Our Community fund. We were donated \$1500 (plus gst). We will be applying to other funders to make up the difference needed to start and complete this project.



Levelled track for easier walking, in particular for descending from the seating area at the viewpoint

Boxed in steps where needed to reduce loss of infill below and above steps

Level sections between steps to allow for rests between climbs



The project starts from the first steps at the bottom of the hill , replacing the existing steps that were built in the 1980s. The steps and first 100 meters to the first chair will be graded to make that first section a lot more accessible and provide a good viewing point from the first chair so that those who are unable to go any further up the hill can still see the magical views over Kurow.

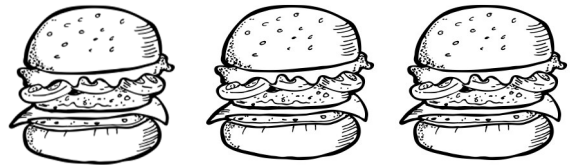

# Kurow Wetland Group



A lot of machinery work has been happening on the South Bank of the wetland. A 20 tonne mulcher has started the work on eradicating the weeds and willows from the side of the wetland and the area above the bank. (A walk or drive along the service lane behind the shops will give you a good idea on what's been happening. The area we will be concentrating on this winter is the south side and alps2ocean end of the wetland. More machinery work will be planned for August where we will be taking the willow that's actually in the water out. The work has been made possible by funding from ECAN.

The work we have done so far on the south bank has exposed years of rubbish dumping over the bank. Engines; tyres ;tin; bottles; drums etc. We will endeavor to clean all this up over the next 12 months.

Meanwhile we are looking into the history of what was a swampy body of water . We have been told by locals (old enough to remember ford prefects; Morris minors; Anglias.....) that what we now refer to as a wetland was a sewerage outlet for the town. Once we have enough correct information we would like to put an informational panel down in the wetland of its history. If you have any old photos of the old sewerage system or that body of water we call the wetland then we would love to see them.

With the leaves now gone on the large trees in the wetland , the walk through it feels totally different than in the height of Summer. Take time out to go for a stroll.

Through this funding we also hope to organise beginner Te Reo classes and are currently on the lookout for a Kaiako, so if you happen to know someone who could help, please get in touch.

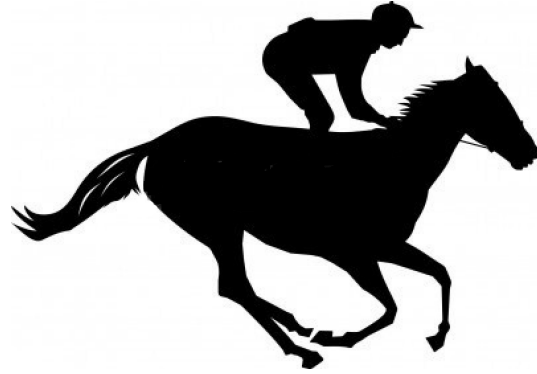
